

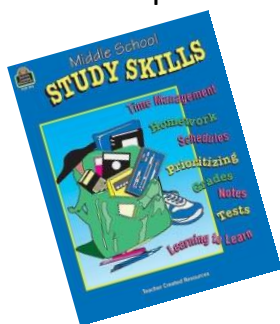
Middle School Success Program
